This cruise vacation will be filled with boatloads of activities, wonderful adventures and unforgettable experiences for both you and your little ones. This weekly planner will allow you to find out about all the amazing things happening for our Royal Babies (6 to 18 months) and Royal Tots (18 to 36 months) while you enjoy the next days onboard your Royal Caribbean International cruise vacation.

In order to register your child in the Royal Babies and Tots Nursery, you will need to bring your SeaPass card as well as your child's card. Once we have gathered medical information and names of authorized family members and friends to pick up your child, you may begin to book requested hours in the Nursery. On Day 1 and Day 2, we will offer each family a set number of booking hours. Later in the voyage we will open up all left over hours to be given away on a first come first serve basis.

An hourly fee of \$6 per child will apply for services in daytime. And an hourly fee of \$8 per child will apply for services after 6:00 pm.

PLEASE NOTE:

All bookings for the days in port should be made at least 24 hours in advance to assure service will be provided. If you have booked a shore excursion with Royal Caribbean and require care for you child outside of the Nursery opening hours, please let the Nursery staff know and we will discuss the plan to ensure care.

Please note: After 10:00 pm each evening the Royal Babies and Tots nursery will close 10 minutes after the last booked child has been signed out. To guarantee care for your child, booking in advance is highly recommended.





What must I bring with my child? The Nursery will stock a small limited supply of essential childcare items, however, parents are required to provide any personal items their child may need during their stay including: diapers, wipes, bottles and milk, food or snacks, sippy cups, an extra set of clothes and personal comfort items. Please note: the Royal Babies and Tots Nursery cannot hold any fresh food for longer than three hours.

Cancellation and Late Pick Up Policy

We require 2 hours notice to cancel a reservation and avoid paying a fee. A charge of 50% will be charged if less than 2 hours notice is given prior to the scheduled session.

Guests will be charged a \$1 late fee each minute late per child starting at minute 16. However, guests will not be charged if a shipboard activity or shipboard purchased shore excursion runs late. We thank you for your consideration.

Royal Babies and Tots Child Behavior Policy
Behavior deemed inappropriate by Royal Babies and Royal Tots will not be permitted within the facilities. We require complete family cooperation, up to and including the dismissal of any child from activities if behavior continues to be inappropriate after continued communication with the family.

Toy Lending Program

PLAY TIPS

OBSERVE YOUR CHILD AT PLAY
